Pathways Awareness Foundation 25th Anniversary Dinner

At this event, hosted by Shirley Welsh Ryan and Maggie Daley, the 2009 Pathways Pioneer Award was awarded to the thousands of children around the world who work as hard as Olympians to achieve what many of us take for granted.

Pathways Awareness, a national not-for-profit, focuses on raising awareness and providing tools for the detection, intervention and prevention of early motor delays in children.

Each year, more than 400,000 children in the U.S. are at risk for an early motor delay. Dr. John Sarwark and Dr. Garry Gardner, co-chairs of the Pathways Medical Round Table—which consists of the nation's top experts in early motor development, presented the award to Kelly O'Brien and Kaitlyn O'Brien, who accepted the honor on behalf of millions of children around the world who have experienced early motor delays and who have benefited from early detection and intervention.
